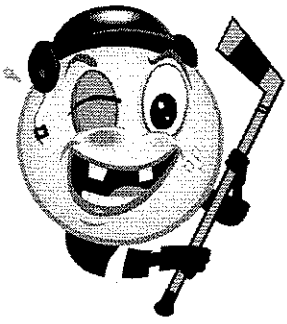

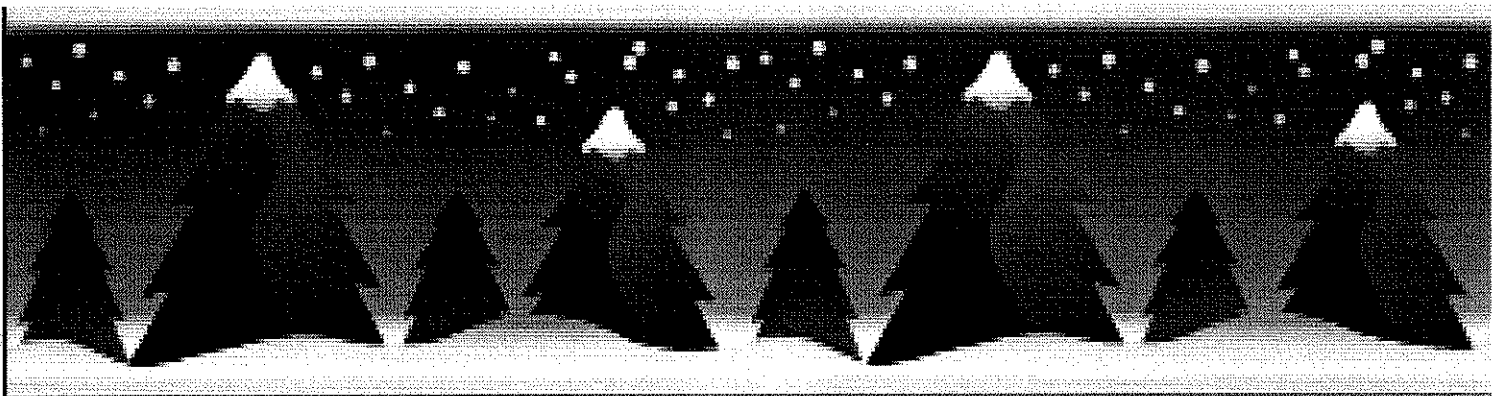
RECREATION NEWS!!!

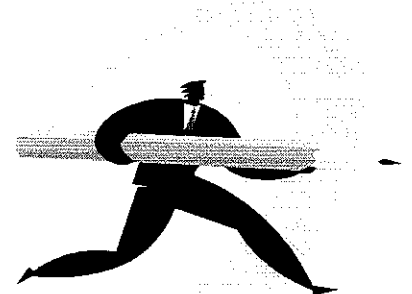

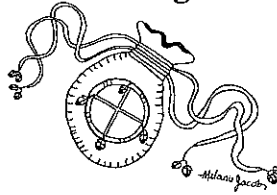

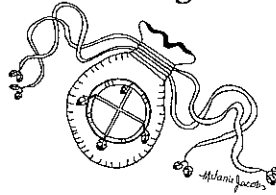
